*Prior authorization for major organ,\* bone marrow and stem cell transplants must be coordinated through our transplant team and submitted by the transplant facility. All participating providers who offer transplant services may not be designated as a Preferred Transplant Center. Please call 1-866-356-2425 for a list of all participating providers and facilities.*

*\*Some special rules apply to kidney and corneal transplants:*

- Covered on the same basis as any other illness
- Not included in the EPNI transplant network
- Do not require prior authorization
